LAKE ALMADOR

Boat Bites in Best While Trout Remain Scattered

Chesler - Lake Almador received another (trout-needed) dose of late this weekend, every little bit helps. Lake level has begun dropping, the first time in months. Water temperature continues to lower around the early degree mark and stability ranges between 7-10°. We will start to see a warmup later this week with daytime highs reaching into the high 60s again.

The lake remains inconsistent for folks as we wait for the weather and water temperatures to stabilize. Trout are scattered and I have heard reports of fish caught on the East Shore, West shore off Rocky Point, Bay 1 to the A-Frames and off Reed Bank. I still have not seen any signs of the best hatch on Almador we are still a week or two away. Tactics need to pick your preferred presentation and cover ground, start at the popular hauls, and stay on fish when you find them.

Boat fishermen continue to catch quality fish when weathered permit. Shore fishermen are targeting their efforts around Hardier Branch. We are beginning to see fly fishermen along the west shore in the morning in search of less activity. But Lake should see hatches beginning this week.

You can expect traffic delays when boating to Phelan County and please call ahead for lodging, dining, and camping reservations.
